Today, Mr. Vij, APP, UT, Chandigarh, on instructions from SI Kulwant Singh states that it has been corroborated that in fact the marriage of the sister of the petitioner is fixed for 28.06.2018. It is case of the petitioner that he may be sent to attend this marriage under police escort at his own expenses.

In view of the statement made by learned APP, UT, Chandigarh, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the prayer. Since the marriage is scheduled for 28.06.2018 i.e. day after tomorrow and the petitioner is to reach Uttar Pradesh (UP), the respondents are directed to ensure that the petitioner is able to make it for the marriage under whatever security which maybe required at his expenses. The petitioner will return back on 29.06.2018.
