Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has all along been senior to the private respondents. At the time of promotion to the post of Assistant Sub Inspectors, the petitioner has been shown senior to the private respondents but by ignoring his seniority the private respondents have been promoted to the post of officiating Sub Inspectors and claim of the petitioner has been ignored vide impugned order dated 14.12.2017 (Annexure P-8).

Notice of motion.

Mr. Rajesh Gaur, Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Let five copies of the complete paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day. In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no need to seek written statement.

Considering the nature of the relief being sought by the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition by directing respondent No.3-The Commissioner of Police to consider the writ petition as a representation against order dated 14.12.2017 (Annexure P-8), and pass a speaking order thereupon, within a period of eight weeks from the

date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
