By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant him the benefit of pay scale of 1200-2400/- w.e.f. 01.05.1990 along-with all consequential benefits and arrears in view of judgments passed by this Court in CWP No. 2023 of 2011, titled **Mange Ram and others vs. State of Haryana** (P-2) and CWP No. 11117 of 2013, titled as **Mahesh Chand Sharma and other vs. State of Haryana and others** (P-5).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that though a legal notice dated 05.02.2018 (P-6) was duly served upon the respondents but despite of the fact that a period of more than three months has expired, till date neither any reply to the notice has been received nor any conscious decision has been taken.

3. At this juncture, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the afore-said legal notice dated 05.02.2018 (P-6) in a time bound manner.

4. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case but considering the afore-said aspects, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 05.02.2018 (P-6) and to take a conscious decision in accordance with law, rules, regulations and instructions issued by the Government from time to time as well as judgments referred in the 1st para of this order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

5. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available under law including to approach this Court.
