JASPAL SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to decide his legal notice dated 15.03.2018 (P-4) for counting his seniority w.e.f. 1991.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide above said legal notice (P-4), within some specified period.

3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 15.03.2018 (P-4) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

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4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
