By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant him the benefits of higher pay scale and to pay arrears thereof, from 01.07.1999 to 10.08.2003 and 11.08.2003 to 12.04.2005 with further direction to make the payment of differences in the salary payable on the higher scale post along-with interest till actual realization of the due amount in view of judgment rendered by this Court in CWP No. 6723 of 2004, titled as **Pritam Singh vs. State of Punjab and others;** decided on 23.08.2004.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that petitioner moved a representation dated 05.06.2015 (P-2), which was followed by subsequent reminders dated 04.04.2016 (P-3) and 02.12.2017 (P-4) but till date

neither any reply has been received nor any conscious decision has been taken by the authorities

3. At this juncture, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide his representation as well as subsequent reminders in a time bound manner.

4. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case but considering the afore-said aspects, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated 05.06.2015 (P-2) and to take a conscious decision in accordance with law, rules, regulations and also in view of **Pritam Singh's case (supra)**, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

5. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available under law including to approach this Court.
