This petition has served its purpose when a direction was sought to fill up vacant sanctioned posts of Teachers in secondary schools on a regular basis through process provided under the Constitutional Scheme of employment in view of disclosure by the State Counsel in memo dated 03.04.2018 addressed by Principal Secretary to Government Haryana, School Education Department, Chandigarh to the Secretary, Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Panchkula on the subject of recruitment to the posts of Post Graduate Teacher (PGT) Computer Science in secondary Education Department, Haryana (Except Mewat Cadre) on regularization has been sent by way of requisition to fill up 1373 posts of Post Graduate Teachers to be filled up by way of direct recruitment in the Secondary Education Department, Haryana. These posts are bifurcated as per Government's Instruction No. 22/10/2013-1GSIII dated 15.07.2014 on subject of

reservation in Government jobs and the same is annexed as Annex. 'A'. The qualifications for the posts are as prescribed in the Haryana State Education School Cadre (Group-B) Service Rules, 2012, a copy of which has been enclosed and sent to the Commission for necessary action.

Accordingly, the Haryana Staff Selection Commission is seized of the selection. The concern of the Court recorded in the order dated 11.07.2017 has been assuaged cautioning that interim arrangements for the better education will no longer be the order of the day “and the need of the hour” as pointed out by Brother G.S. Sandhawalia, J.

In view of the requisition sent to the Commission, this petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such with the hope that the Commission would take immediate steps to fulfill the promise of the recruitment. The State is also directed to address the issue of making regular recruitments at High School level expeditiously so that computer education permeates the entire student body in the various schools in Haryana run by the Education Department i.e. Elementary/Primary School and Higher School Education.

Disposed of.
