**HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J.(ORAL)**

In the present case, notice of motion was issued on 28.09.2016.

The contention raised before this Court was that after the death of her husband, the petitioner, who was entitled for the Gratuity, Leave Encashment in respect of the services rendered by her late husband, had not been released to her.

The respondents have placed on record order dated 27.04.2018 (Annexure R-1) wherein it has been mentioned that all the dues for which late Sh. Sewa Singh was entitled for, have been released to his legal heirs.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner on the last two hearings. This is probably for the reason that all the benefits have already been released to the petitioner.

In case, the petitioner is entitled for any other relief apart from the relief already released by the respondents, the petitioner will be at liberty to file a representation including the grant of interest for the delayed payments.

In case, any representation is filed in this regard by the petitioner, the respondents shall dispose of the same within a period of two months from the date of receipt of the same by passing a speaking order.

The writ petition stands disposed of, in above terms.
