Petitioners No.1 and 2 have FIRs against them. Petitioners No.3 to 7 may file their statements of defence and show to the Suspending and Transferring Authority that the impugned decision suspending and transferring them to different depots of the Haryana Roadways is not a correct decision.

The petition has been filed against suspension-cum transfer orders. It is rather premature to say anything on merits of the claim or to express any final opinion on the passing of the suspension orders.

Accordingly, this petition is disposed of by permitting the petitioners in two sets i.e. petitioners No.1 and 2 and the other containing names of the petitioners No.3 to 7 to represent to the General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Jhajjar to look into the matter, within three days to hear

the petitioners and decide whether the suspension is justified and whether the complaint on the basis of the adverse orders was genuine and in public interest. The General Manager would also have regard to the preliminary investigation made by the police and after considering all aspects take a consiousl decision within 10 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Meanwhile, when the decision is taken, the same be put up before the Head of the Department to see whether the petitioners have been dealt with fairly.

With these observations, the present petition is disposed of.
