Considering the nature of the relief sought by the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this writ petition at this stage with direction to respondent No.2, to objectively consider the legal notice dated 02.04.2018 (Annexure P-23), by passing a speaking order thereupon, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

In case the petitioner is found entitled, the benefits thereof be released within four week thereafter.
