The petitioner claims herself to be a widow of Hara Singh who has died a civil death. Till date there is no declaration to this effect. Therefore, the locus is clearly manifesting itself. Besides, the petitioner has described herself as below:-

“Rewal Kaur wd/o Sh. Hara Singh, resident of H.No.1067, Sector 15-B, Chandigarh died civil death owner/lessee of Industrial Shed no.1053, Industrial Area, Phase 2, Chandigarh to the extent of 50% through legal representative Sh.Tejinder Singh s/o Sh. Teja Singh, r/o H.No.578, Phase 3B1, Mohali, SAS Nagar being beneficiary to the extent of 25% registered will dated 21.3.1989 executed by Smt. Rawal Kaur.”

The aforesaid indicates that the petition itself is not by her.

Confronted with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to file a fresh one on the same cause of action.

Permitted to do so.

In view of above, instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn. It is made clear that petitioner can file a fresh petition, if at any stage, she is held to be a widow of Hara Singh on account of his civil death and in the event of acquiring any interest in the property.
