At the first instance, the petitioners may raise their grievances before the competent authority in the Transport Department against their transfer by filing a representation within three days, which will be considered within seven days thereafter. Till such time, status quo will be maintained.

The petitioners will be heard and in case adverse order is to be passed and transfer is to be maintained, then reasons for the transfer must be given to them, which should spell public interest and administrative exigencies.

With these directions, the instant petition stands disposed of.
