RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J. (Oral)

This is yet another example of an employee on the ministerial side of the Transport Department, Haryana asserting his rights for overtime and extra wages for working on Saturdays without paying due regard to his duties. If the petitioner works on Saturdays just as other similarly-placed employees in the department consistent with the discharge of public duties on Saturdays in the same public utility department, and nurtures a complaint sufficient to move the High Court for a mandamus convinced of success, he is free to leave the job and find one which offers more comfort.

Municipal Employees Union (Regd) Sirhind & Others v. State of Punjab & Others, (2009) 9 SCC 432 is of no help.
