By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to count the part service rendered by him w.e.f. 15.04.1985 to 24.04.2006 for the purposes of pension and other retiral benefits and also to release the arrears along-with interest as well as to release leave encashment of 152 days with further direction to decide the legal notice dated 15.02.2018 (P-5) within some limited period.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that though a legal notice dated 15.02.2018 (P-5) was duly served upon the respondents, despite of the fact that a period of more than three months has expired, till date neither any reply to the notice has been received nor any conscious decision has been taken.

3. At this juncture, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents No.2 & 3 to consider and decide the afore-said legal notice dated 15.02.2018 (P-5) in a time bound manner.

4. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case but considering the afore-said aspects, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 15.02.2018 (P-5) and to take a conscious decision in accordance with law, rules, regulations and instructions issued by the Government from time to time, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

5. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available under law including to approach this Court.
