Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioner from the date on which his juniors have been regularized alongwith all consequential benefits at the rate of 24% interest.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though a legal notice was made to the respondents on May 01, 2017 (Annexure P-7) but till date neither any reply to the said legal notice has been received nor any final order has been passed by the concerned Department.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondents particularly respondent No.4 to decide his legal notice dated May 01, 2017 (AnnexureP-7) within some specified period.

4. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents

particularly respondent No.4-i.e. Executive Engineer, Mansa Division, I.B. Jawaharke, Distt. Mansa, to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice dated May 01, 2017 (AnnexureP-7) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order as per rules and instructions issued by the Government from time to time within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

5. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
