Mr. Rathee has filed reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Rejender Singh, Superintendent, District Jail, Yamuna Nagar on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner Anik Bansal, who was convicted and sentenced to two years simple imprisonment by way of present petition seeks temporary release on emergency parole for a period of four weeks on account of illness of his father.

The petitioner had applied for parole through representation dated 17.05.2018 before respondent No.3 but no decision had been taken. The doctor has also given an opinion that the father of the petitioner is suffering from depression and requires treatment. A copy

of the representation Annex. P1 and opinion of the doctor dated 29.05.2018 is annex. P-2 have been placed on record. Municipal Councilor has also certified the same and a copy of the certification is Annex. P-3. Thus, it would be just and expedient that four weeks' parole is granted to the petitioner to enable him to look after his father and arrange for his medical treatment.

Accordingly, the instant petition is accepted and the respondents are directed to release the petitioner on parole for four weeks to be counted from the date of his release subject to his furnishing personal bond and surety to the satisfaction of the concerned District Magistrate. The petitioner shall surrender in jail after the expiry of four weeks.
