Present petition has been filed against a show cause notices dated 03.05.2018 and 27.04.2018, issued on the departmental side, reply to which was to be filed within the stipulated period of 15 days from the receipt of the memorandum. The petitioner, thus, has an opportunity to approach the respondents, which would be clear from a perusal of Annexures P1 to P3.

Counsel fairly submits that the petitioner has not given any detailed reply to the same. In such circumstances, it will always be open to the petitioner to approach the respondents to put-forth his side of the case and to bring to their notice as to why further proceedings should not continue, as has been contended herein.

Accordingly, in view of the above, the present writ petition is dismissed, as not maintainable, at this stage, with the aforesaid liberty.
