KRISHNA MURARI, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral):

The petitioner has approached this Court seeking mandamus to command the respondents and particularly respondent No.3 to look into the complaint made by him regarding high volume of speaker of Gurudwara Singh Sabha, Bhadson, Patiala. From the pleadings we find that earlier a complaint was made by the petitioner and with the intervention by the police and other authorities, a compromise was arrived at and the priest of the Gurudwara Sahib agreed not to play the loudspeaker at a high volume. It appears that breaching the undertaking, the volume of the loudspeaker has been increased and aggrieved against the same the petitioner has approached this Court. In our considered opinion, this is an issue which can be better appreciated and set at rest by administrative authorities. The petitioner has already made a representation with respect to the grievance to respondent No.3 (Deputy Commissioner, Patiala), dated 19.03.2018

(Annexure P-1). We deem it appropriate to dispose of this writ petition by commanding respondent No.3 to look into the complaint made by the petitioner and settle the dispute after hearing both the sides, if necessary. The representation be disposed of within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
