This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant the petitioner benefit of proficiency step up on completion of 9 years service under ACP scheme dated 23.04.1990 from the due date along with consequential benefits with 18 % interest per annum.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.3-The Chief Engineer, WEST, Punjab State Power Corporation Ltd., District Bathinda to consider and decide the representation dated 23.03.2018 (Annexure P-4).

Heard.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the

case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3- The Chief Engineer, WEST, Punjab State Power Corporation Ltd., District Bathinda to consider and decide the representation dated 23.03.2018 (Annexure P-4) within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible to him or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
