Petitioner is serving as Technical Assistant with the Sate Warehouse, Sangrur. Punishment order dated 02.02.2018 (P-1) was passed and recovery of amount of Rs.2,78,863.33/- stands passed against the petitioner.

Petitioner is stated to have filed his statutory appeal dated 20.02.2018 (P-2) before the Appellate Authority-respondent no.2.

The limited prayer is for directing the Appellate Authority to decide the pending appeal within a time frame.

Upon notice Mr. Suman Jain, Advocate appearing on behalf of the respondents-Punjab State Warehousing Corporation states that in view of the previous orders passed in similar cases at Annexure P-3 to P-12 he

has no objection if the present petition is also disposed of with a direction to

the Appellate Authority to decide the pending appeal within a period of four months from today.

In view of the aforesaid stand of the Counsel for the respondents, the **present petition is disposed of** with the **directions** that the statutory appeal filed before the Appellate Authority shall be decided within a period of next four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this Order. No future recoveries till then shall be effected from the salary of the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner undertakes to furnish requisite number of copies of the writ petition to the counsel for the respondents during the course of the day.
