AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

It is the contention of learned counsel for the petitioner that the application dated 22.01.2017 (Annexure P-4) for correction of khasra girdawari is pending before the Tehsildar-cum-Assistant Collector 1st Grade, Amritsar-II, wherein after notice and reply of the private respondents, parties were directed to be present on the spot on 06.07.2017 but the Tehsildar neither visited the spot nor has any subsequent date been fixed for consideration or orders. Counsel contends that despite various efforts made by the petitioner including submission of representation dated 02.03.2018 (Annexure P-5) to the Financial Commissioner (Revenue), Punjab as well as Commissioner, Jalandhar Division, Jalandhar-respondents 1 and 2 respectively, highlighting the said aspect but till date nothing has been done in the matter. He prays that the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the application dated 22.01.2017 of the petitioner within some specified time.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Tehsildar-cum-Assistant Collector 1st Grade, Amritsar-II-respondent No.3, that in case the assertion of the petitioner is found to be correct and a

(Annexure P-4) for correction of khasra girdawari, he shall proceed to decide the same in accordance with law, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
