This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned orders dated 23.08.2016 and 10.03.2017 (Annexures P-8 and P-10) passed by respondent No.2 whereby claim of the petitioner for appointment as Junior Scientific Officer was rejected.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2- Member Secretary, Punjab Pollution Control Board, Vatavaran Bhawan, Nabha Road, Patiala to consider and decide the legal notice/representation dated 30.03.2017 (Annexure P-11).

In the circumstances, respondent No.2- Member Secretary, Punjab Pollution Control Board, Vatavaran Bhawan, Nabha Road, Patiala is directed to consider and decide the legal notice/representation dated

30.03.2017 (Annexure P-11) by indicating as to how (Annexure P-7) cannot be treated as experience certificate, by passing a speaking order within a period of six weeks from the receipt of certified copy of the order. In case, the competitive authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not made out, then a speaking order be passed in this regard.
