Main Case

By way of the present petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 & 2 to appoint the petitioner as Art & Craft teacher against the category of Scheduled Caste (Balmiki & Majhbi Sikh) as the same has not been filled up and in view of the fact that the candidate lower in merit including respondent No.3 have been given appointment as Art & Craft teacher.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner states that as of now two vacancies in the category of SC (M&B) are available.

The petitioner being fully eligible is entitled for the post in question.

This factual aspect of the matter is duly acknowledged by learned State counsel and states that the candidature of the petitioner will be considered as per eligibility criteria and rules.

Heard.

Keeping in view the admitted position, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 that in case the petitioner fulfils the eligibility prescribed in the advertisement, in that eventuality, the post in question be offered to him. Needful be done within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
