The prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to respondent No.5 to comply with order dated 20.12.2016 (Annexure P-2) and order dated 22.05.2017 (Annexure P-4) in a time bound manner.

On perusal of said two orders and other documents on the file, it is apparent that Shimla Devi (since deceased) predecessor-in-interest of the petitioner had earlier approached this Court by way of filing CWP No.6122 of 2017 and the said petition was dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to move an application before the authority for delivery of possession. Although, in pursuance of that direction, a representation was made on 05.12.2017, whereas in the present petition the prayer has been made to comply with order dated 20.12.2016 and 22.05.2017. No direction can be issued in the present petition since liberty has already been given to the petitioner.

Dismissed.

However, the petitioner is at liberty to pursue the representation.
