By way of the present petition, the petitioners seek issuance of directions to the respondents to re-fix the date of regular appointment of the petitioners by counting at least half of their daily wage service towards qualifying service for pension at par with the employees paid from contingencies.

Despite sufficient opportunities, no reply has been filed on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that at this stage, he will be satisfied in case the respondents are directed to consider and decide the case of the petitioner(s) in view of the ratio of law laid down by this Court in CWP-2371-2010 titled as **Harbans Lal** Vs. **State of Punjab and others**, decided on 31.08.2010.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents states that he has no objection in case the submission made by learned counsel for the petitioners is accepted.

Heard.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner(s) in the light of assertion made. If, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the case of the petitioners is at par with the petitioner (s) in the above said judgment, the competent authority is directed to pass the consequential order within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioners is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
