By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the respondents to grant the benefits of Senior Assistant w.e.f 01.01.1978 and Superintendent w.e.f. 01.01.1986 along with all consequential benefits from the date when their juniors/similarly situated employees have been granted the deemed date of promotion to the post of Senior Assistant and Superintendent.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, he will be satisfied in case, respondent No.2 is directed to take a decision on legal notice dated 07.07.2015 (Annexure P-6) served by the petitioner.

Heard.

In view of the statement made, the Court is not inclined to issue notice of motion, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, to take a decision on legal notice dated 07.07.2015

(Annexure P-6), within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of three months thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
