By way of the present petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to transfer the petitioner from PHC Dhilwan, Sub Division Nadala, District Kapurthala to CHC Gharota, District Pathankot on vacant post from 30.06.2018 on account of retirement of one Amarjit Kaur MPS (F) from CHC Gharota.

Learned counsel states that at this stage he would be satisfied in case the respondent No.3-Director Health and Family Welfare Department, Punjab, Sector-34-A, Chandigarh is directed to consider and decide the application/representation (Annexure P-1) in the light of instructions dated 23.04.2018 (Annexure P-6) in a time bound manner.

Heard.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent

No.3-Director Health and Family Welfare Department, Punjab, Sector-34-A, Chandigarh to consider and decide the application/representation (Annexure P-1) in the light of instructions dated 23.04.2018 (Annexure P-6) within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to her, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to her, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
