In response to the advertisement Annexure P3, the petitioners had competed for selection to the post of Multi Purpose Health Workers in OBC and General Categories, respectively. Pursuant to an interim order dated 09.10.2015, they were permitted to appear in the examination held by the respondent-authorities on 11.10.2015 provisionally. The results of the petitioners have been produced today in a seal cover which have since been opened, and it shows that petitioner No.1, 2 & 4 had obtained 45.50, 20.75 & 11.50 marks, whereas the last candidate, in their category, had secured 54.25 marks. Likewise, petitioner No.3 had obtained 30.00 marks and the last candidate in his category had secured 41.5 marks. Thus, all the petitioners have failed to qualify for selection.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that nothing substantive survives in this petition and the same be disposed of as such.

Disposed of as having rendered infructuous.
