The petitioners have filed this petition seeking quashing of order dated 05.06.2018 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No.2-District Magistrate, Faridabad, whereby they have been directed to be evicted from H.No.5C/69, NIT Faridabad, Haryana, under Action Plan for the Protection of Life and Property of Senior Citizen Act, 2007.

Petitioners are son and daughter-in-law of respondent No.3 and on account of some misunderstandings, dispute arose between the close family relations.

Today, petitioner No.1 (Gurmeet Singh) and respondent No.3 (Ram Singh) were present in Court and were referred for mediation. With the assistance of Mr. Ajay Kaushik, Advocate/Mediator, they have resolved the dispute and a compromise dated 02.07.2018 has been reduced into writing, which has been signed by both the parties. As per this compromise,

respondent No.3 shall pay a sum of Rs.20,10,000/- (Rupees Twenty Lacs

Ten Thousands only) on or before 02.10.2018 to petitioner No.1. On receipt of payment, petitioner No.1 will vacate portion of the house in his possession along with Dhaba within one month from the date of receipt of said amount. The entire dispute between the parties has now been resolved and they have agreed not to initiate any proceeding against each other.

Since, the matter has been amicable settled between the parties, this petition is disposed of as per terms of the compromise. The settlement agreement dated 02.07.2018 is being made part of this order. Both the parties shall remain bound by the terms of the compromise.
