On our asking, Ms.Geeta Sharma, Advocate, accepts notice on their behalf.

Let two copies of the writ petition be handed-over to her during the course of day failing which this order shall be automatically recalled and the writ petition shall be deemed to have been dismissed for non-prosecution.

In view of the nature of order which we propose to pass, it is not necessary to seek any counter-reply from respondent Nos.1 & 2 at this stage.

Similarly, no order adverse to the interest of respondent No.3 is being passed, hence, we do not deem it necessary to call upon him at this stage.

The petitioner is a Residents Welfare Association of Mahavir Enclave, Hambran Road, Ludhiana. It alleges that immediate outside the

unauthorized construction which has become a source of nuisance for the residents of the colony. The petitioner-Association thus seeks a direction to GLADA authorities to permit the petitioner to install a gate at the main entrance for the safety and security of its residents. A complaint to this effect has been made on 26.05.2018 (P-2).

As stated above, we have not heard respondent No.3 or the official respondents at this stage. Thus, no view can be expressed on merits of the allegations made by the petitioner-Association. Suffice it would be to dispose of this writ petition with a direction to the Estate Officer, GLADA to visit the site, hear the representative of the petitioner-Association as well as respondent No.3 and take an appropriate decision on the petitioner's complaint strictly in accordance with law, within a period of two months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
