MAHESH GROVER, J.(ORAL)

By this order we will dispose of two Civil Writ Petitions
bearing CWP nos. 15643 and 16270 of 2018.

Mr. Jhanji, learned counsel representing PGIMER states that in
the counselling Dr. Sagar Khera (petitioner in CWP no. 15643 of 2018) has
got Internal Medicine, stream of his choice. Likewise, Dr. Rajesh Kapoor

(petitioner in CWP no. 16270 of 2018) has also got Pediatrics, again the stream of his choice. According to Mr. Jhanji since this was the claim of the petitioners in both the petitions, their consideration in the counselling and acceptance of the stream allocated has rendered the instant petitions infructuous.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioners to either accept or reject the submission made by the learned counsel for the respondent. Therefore, we while accepting the statement made by the learned counsel for the respondent, dismiss the instant petitions as having become infructuous but before parting with the order we notice lack of courtesy by the petitioners in not appearing before this Court. During the course of proceedings, a great urgency had been demonstrated which we while noticing had granted short adjournments and spent considerable time on it. The absence of the petitioners is a discourtesy to the Court. We, therefore, impose costs of Rs.2000/- each on the petitioners in both the petitions which shall be deposited before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
