Petitioner seeks grant of emergency parole for six weeks so as to solemnize his 3rd marriage. At the last date of hearing a direction had been issued to the learned State counsel to verify the factum of the marriage of the petitioner.

Learned State Counsel has today filed its reply wherein the fact that the marriage of the petitioner is fixed for 30.6.2018 has been verified but it has been stated that there is apprehension of breach of peace in the village and that on earlier occasion the petitioner had absconded while on parole. The State in its reply has also furnished details of 14 other cases in which the petitioner stands convicted. In another 28 cases, the petitioner has however, been acquitted. The learned State counsel has also informed that one more case is pending against the petitioner i.e. FIR No.111 dated 25.3.2018 under Section 115 of IPC and 25, 54, 59 of the Arms Act, Police Station City Dadri, District Charkhi Dadri and has submitted that in fact the said offence was

The aforestated position indicates that the petitioner is a seasoned criminal and that he had earlier committed offences even while on parole. As such, this Court does not find sufficient grounds to grant parole for six weeks to the petitioner. However, since the State has verified the fact that the marriage of the petitioner is fixed for 30.6.2018, the petition is accepted to the limited extent that the petitioner shall be taken out in custody for one day so as to enable him to solemnize his marriage on 30.6.2018. After solemnization of marriage, the petitioner shall be consigned back in the jail, on the same day itself. The expenditure for the entire exercise shall be borne out by the petitioner.
