The present petition has been filed with a prayer for quashing of order dated 04.06.2018 (Annexure P-11) passed by the Punjab State Electricity Regulatory Commission, Chandigarh.

The petition involves certain disputed questions of facts. There is a statutory remedy of appeal provided under Section 111 of the Electricity Act, 2003. In such circumstances, the petitioner is relegated to the remedy of appeal.

The grievances of the petitioner is that it has already deposited Rs.3.5 Crores approximately and further grievance is that the respondents are not making the payments of electricity already supplied hence, there is an urgency in the matter.

Needless to add that after filing of the appeal, if a request is made to the Appellate Authority for the early disposal of the appeal, the same would be considered by the Appellate Authority in accordance with law and as expeditiously as possible.

The present petition stands disposed of.
