Petitioner's claim is that he is a street vendor and running his business in Sector 23-A, Chandigarh on V-5 road for the last 40 years and he is protected under the Street Vendors (Protection of Livelihood and Regulation of Street Vending) Act, 2014. Further he is a licensed vendor under the Vending Policy and therefore, he cannot be re-located from the said place. Further he has been regularly paying the dues to the Municipal Corporation, U.T., Chandigarh, yet some police personnel from Sector 17 Police Station and Police Chowki, Sector 22, Chandigarh are harassing him and threatening him to remove from the said place.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he would be satisfied at this stage if a direction is given to the respondent No.2-Sr. Superintendent of Police, U.T., Chandigarh to decide his representation (Annexure P-7).

I find this to be a fair request. Consequently, the respondent No.2-Sr. Superintendent of Police, U.T., Chandigarh is directed to look into the matter and decide the representation (Annexure P-7) expeditiously.

Petition stands disposed of.
