Petitioner is employed as Statistical Assistant with the respondent-department. A departmental inquiry was initiated against him on account of misconduct and having been found guilty vide order dated 03.09.2016 (Annexure P1), his one increment was stopped with cumulative effect. Being aggrieved against the order of punishment, he had filed an appeal, which too was dismissed by the appellate authority, vide order dated 29.12.2016/02.01.2017. He purports to have filed a revision dated 12.03.2017 (Annexure P3), which is alleged to have been pending before respondent No.1. The limited grievance that the petitioner has is; that even though a considerable time has elapsed, but his matter continues to await consideration of the competent authority. So much so, even a reminder dated 24.09.2017 (Annexure P4) the respondents had even been served, but that too has failed to evoke any response. And no result is insight either.

That being so, the petition is disposed of, at this stage, only with a direction to respondent No.1 that, if indeed, any such revision filed by the petitioner is pending, the same shall be considered and decided, in accordance with law, within a period of 8 weeks from the receipt of certified copy of this order. And an appropriate order shall be passed.
