JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J.

The present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for directing the respondents to grant four weeks emergency parole to the petitioner to look after his wife, whose delivery is due on 12.7.2018.

In pursuance of order dated 3.7.2018, status report has been filed by the learned State counsel. As per the same, the wife of the petitioner is at the advanced stage of pregnancy and delivery is expected on 12.7.2018. The antecedents of the petitioner were also verified from Sh.Shyam Singh, Lambardar of the village and member panchayat Ashok Kumar. The petitioner has already availed parole and never misused the same.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on four weeks emergency parole subject to his furnishing bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the Duty Magistrate/ CJM, Panipat. The specific date of surrender by the petitioner shall also be indicated by the releasing Court.
