MAHESH GROVER, J. (Oral)

Contends that he would have otherwise been entitled for admission in the course in question if the income certificate submitted by him correctly depicted the income of his family but due to oversight the income of the father was excluded. Since the original certificate submitted, on consideration, would oust the petitioner from the zone of consideration, he prays that fresh certificate depicting the correct picture after inclusion of his father's income be considered valid. In this regard the petitioner has submitted a representation which is on record as Annexure P-8.

We would, therefore, without commenting on the merits of the case deem it appropriate to dispose of the present petition with a direction to respondent No.4 to consider the representation (Annexure P-8) in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, preferably before the conclusion of the admission process. Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands disposed of.
