JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner-Harvinder Singh is working as Regular Team Mate in one of the office at Jalandhar of the Punjab State Power Corporation Limited (in short 'PSPCL'). His primary claimed relief is for promotion to the post of Oil Cleaner w.e.f. 29.05.2009, i.e., the date his junior, namely, Mr. Dheeraj Joshi (respondent No. 5 herein) was promoted.

Upon notice, a written statement has been filed on behalf of the respondents/PSPCL, contesting the claim.

However, at the time of arguments, learned counsel for the respondents/PSPCL states that the matter has been reconsidered and vide order dated 12.05.2016, the claimed relief has been granted to the petitioner and he has been promoted as Oil Cleaner w.e.f. 04.10.2009, when his junior/respondent No. 5 was promoted. It is further stated that the said junior/respondent No. 5 has not been further promoted to the higher post of Sub Station Attendant and, therefore, no further relief is warranted.

In view of the aforesaid factual stand, present petition is **disposed of as infructuous.**
