By way of the instant writ petition, under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to consider the case of the petitioner for promotion to the post of Superintendent Grade-II/Grade-I on the basis of passing of examination of Sub Divisional Accounts as provided in Rule 10(d) read with Appendix D of the Rules called Punjab Public Works Department (Irrigation Branch) Circles Clerical State Services, Class-III Rules, 1955 from the date, the persons junior to the petitioner have been promoted.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, he will be satisfied in case, respondent No.2 is directed to take a decision on the representation dated 20.08.2014 (Annexure P-9) moved by the petitioner.

Heard.

In view of the statement made, the Court is not inclined to issue notice of motion, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, to take a decision on the representation dated 20.08.2014 (Annexure P-9) within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of three months thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
