This Court, while issuing notice of motion on 19.11.2013, had passed the following order:-

“ *It is pleaded that the petitioner while serving as Lecturer in English availed of three years sanctioned leave for self-employment w.e.f. 1.7.2010 to 30.6.2013. At that point of time she had been serving at Govt. Girls Senior Secondary School, Abohar. During the period of leave, lien of the petitioner was shifted to Govt. Senior Secondary School, Ghall Khurd, Distt. Ferozepur. Accordingly, petitioner reported back for duty and submitted her joining report on 1.7.2013 with the Principal, Govt. Senior Secondary School, Ghall Khurd, Distt. Ferozepur. However, she was not permitted to join. Thereafter, vide order dated 8.10.2013 at Annexure P-13, passed by the Director Public Instructions (S.E.), Punjab the petitioner was directed to join against the vacant post of Lecturer in English in Govt. Girls Senior Secondary School at Abohar. However, vide memo dated 15.10.2013 issued by the Principal, Govt. Girls Senior Secondary School, Abohar it has been stated that there are two sanctioned posts of Lecturer in English in the institution, which are already filled up and there is no vacant post. Accordingly, the petitioner has not been permitted to join even in Govt. Girls Senior Secondary School at Abohar.*

Grievance raised in the present writ petition is that the petitioner without any fault of her's, is not being permitted to join, even though, she is willing to be adjusted against any school in Ferozerpur, Abohar or Muktsar districts. Counsel further submits that the petitioner is a widow and on account of non-joining of the petitioner she has also not been released her salary w.e.f. July, 2013 onwards.

Notice of motion confined only to respondents no.1 to 3, at this stage.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Sudeepti Sharma, learned D.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents. Requisite copies of the writ paper book be furnished to her during the course of the day.

List on 6.12.2013.

Reply, if any, be filed prior to the adjourned date. ”

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the parties submit that the present writ petition has become infructuous as the petitioner has since retired from government service.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of as infructuous.
