The petitioner competed for selection to the post of Junior Engineer (civil) under the ESM (dependent) category. Pursuant to an interim order dated August 9, 2017, respondents were directed to interview the petitioner provisionally.

The result of the petitioner has been produced in a sealed cover, which has since been opened, and it reveals that total marks obtained by the petitioner are 114. Whereas, the last candidate in the category of the petitioner has secured 146 marks (cut-off). Thus, the petitioner has failed to qualify for selection. Learned State counsel, accordingly, submits that nothing substantive survives in this petition.

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Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petition be disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.
