Only grievance of the petitioner is that a fresh enquiry has been ordered against him by the Deputy Commissioner, Karnal without any material having come on record.

At the outset, learned State counsel submits that there is no bar on holding an enquiry to examine whether there is any truth in the complaint submitted by respondent No.5.

This court finds substance in this plea. Under the circumstances, the writ petition is disposed of. Petitioner shall be allowed to run the depot on the same terms and conditions as stipulated. The concerned authority shall, however, be at liberty to conduct an enquiry. Findings arrived at in the same, shall be considered by respondent No.4 on receipt of enquiry report. Needless to observe that the process may be completed expeditiously.
