1. In all these four petitions, the petitioners are seeking benefit of ACP scale which they contend are due to them but have been denied.

2. The ACP scales not having been refused as yet, the petitioners have sent legal notices to the respondents respectively, copies of which have been annexed with the petitions.

3. Consequently, if the aforesaid legal notices have not been decided so far by passing a speaking order, they shall be decided within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. If the case of the petitioners or any of them has already been rejected for valid reasons, given in any speaking order passed, then only a short order need be passed now, annexing therewith the detailed order passed (if any).

5. If, on the other hand, the petitioners are found eligible for the grant of ACP scales, as contended, the benefits would be released to them with a period of two months thereafter.

6. With the aforesaid observations and directions, these present petitions are disposed of.
