In the instant writ petition, petitioner has challenged the orders of the disciplinary and appellate authorities dated 30.01.2014 and 25.05.2015 respectively.

Petitioner was subjected to disciplinary proceedings on the allegations that he has entered into second marriage while first marriage is subsisting. Only argument is that Preeti Lata Dass has not disclosed that there is marriage between the petitioner and her whereas, authorities have considered evidence of her in detail. As per Annexure P10 it is evident that she has deposed against petitioner to the extent that petitioner married her on 02.11.2013. In view of these facts and circumstances and the fact that petitioner has not raised any legal ground, no interference is called for.

Accordingly, CWP stands dismissed.
