JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner (Sukhjit Kaur) claims herself to be duly eligible for appointment to the post of 'Sister Tutor' governed by the Punjab Health and Family Welfare Technical (Group-'B') Service Rules, 2018, as she possesses the prescribed qualification laid down for direct recruitment.

The grievance raised in the present petition is that the respondent-Department is proceeding to fill-up the vacant posts by way of promotion without offering some of the posts for direct recruitment.

It is submitted that the post of 'Sister Tutor' as per rule is to be filled-up 50% by way of promotion, and 50% by way of direct recruitment.

At the time of hearing, counsel realizing that there is no material placed on record to substantiate his claim of appointment to fill-up the post of 'Sister Tutor' by way of direct recruitment and, therefore, prays for withdrawal of the petition to enable his client to first obtain information under the RTI Act, and then, if so advised, file a fresh petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
