Petitioner has filed instant writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution challenging the relieving order dated 26.06.2018 (P-12) passed by the respondent no.3 whereby he was ordered to be relieved and directed to report at Headquarter.

This Court while issuing notice of motion on 04.07.2018 passed the following order:-

“ Contends that the vide order dated 16.10.2015, the petitioner had been transferred from Panchayat Samiti Bhawanigarh to Panchayat Samiti Bhikhi. Thereafter, vide order dated 11.12.2015, he was again transferred from Panchayat Samiti Bhikhi to Panchayat Samiti Dhuri. Within a month, vide order dated 12.01.2016, the petitioner was transferred back from Panchayat Samiti Dhuri to Panchayat Samiti Bhikhi. Again within a period of four months, order was

passed transferring the petitioner from Bhikhi to Sangrur vide letter dated 31.05.2016. However, on account of cancellation of transfer of respondent No.4 on 19.08.2016, the petitioner was relieved from duty on 26.08.2016 and his place of posting was not shown in the order. Vide order dated 08.12.2016, within a span of four months, the petitioner was again transferred from Head Office Mohali to Sangrur.

Notice of motion for 14.11.2018.

Operation and effect of the order dated 26.06.2018 (Annexure P-12) shall remain stayed till the next date of hearing. ”

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has become infructuous as the impugned order stands cancelled.

Dismissed as infructuous.
