This petition is filed for seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the letters dated 13.12.2016 (Annexure P-14) and dated 19.04.2017 (Annexure P-16) by which a prayer is made by the petitioner for seeking correction of his surname from Desh Mukh to Deshmukh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that except in the record of the CBSE, everywhere the surname of the petitioner is written as Deshmukh. He has thus, prayed that an appropriate direction may be issued to the respondents to make necessary correction in the surname of the petitioner in the Grade Sheet-cum-Certificate of Performance dated 28.05.2016 (Annexure P-10).

After notice, CBSE has put in appearance through its counsel but no reply has been filed.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and after examining

the record, am of the considered opinion that there is a typographical error occurred in the record of the CBSE because the surname of the petitioner has been wrongly mentioned as Desh Mukh instead of Deshmukh.

Consequently, the present petition is allowed and the impugned letters are hereby set aside with a direction to issue Grade Sheet-cum-Certificate of Performance to the petitioner by correcting his surname from Desh Mukh to Deshmukh. It is need less to mention that the necessary certificate shall be issued to the petitioner within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
