The petitioner-Bank has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of mandamus restraining respondent No.1 to pass order on a petition filed under Section 14 of the Securitisation and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 (for short, 'the Act').

2. According to the petitioner, the aforesaid petition/application has been filed on 30.11.2016 and even after one year and seven months, no order has been passed.

3. After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the controversy, we dispose of the present writ petition by directing respondent No.1 to pass a speaking order on the aforesaid petition/application filed under Section 14 of the Act within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner as well as the concerned respondent, in accordance with law.
