The petitioner alleges violation of Rule 9 of the Haryana Municipal Delimitation of Ward Rules, 1977 in issuance of preliminary notification for de-limitation. He states that it is not specific.

We have perused Annexure P-8 and find that grievance is misplaced as each and every ward has been set out with details of de-limitation and objections have been invited. The grievance that specifics have not been provided do not manifest themselves from the impugned notification. Consequently, we dismiss the writ petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioners then contends that the Election Commissioner be directed to hold the elections forthwith. We are of the opinion that in case the petitioners make a representation to the Election Commission, the same shall be considered in accordance with law.
