This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the arrears of difference of salary and allowances of the petitioners who are working as Regular Compute Faculties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.3-Director, School Education Punjab, Punjab ICT Education Society (PICTES), Sikhiya Bhawan, Phase-8, Mohali to accord the finality to the proceedings as reflected in the reply (Annexure P-7).

Heard.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Director, School Education Punjab, Punjab ICT Education Society

(PICTES), Sikhiya Bhawan, Phase-8, Mohali to accord the finality to the proceedings as reflected in the reply (Annexure P-7) within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the order. If the relief claimed by the petitioners is admissible, in such eventuality, the same be granted to them expeditiously as per law.
