Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release his pension and pensionary benefits including Gratuity and Commutation to him along with interest @ 24% p.a. from the date of retirement till the date of actual payment.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though a representation was made to the respondent No.1 on 08.03.2018 (P-3) but till date no final decision has been taken thereof. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide the aforesaid representation (P-3) in a time bound manner.

3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to consider the

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grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the representation dated 08.03.2018 (P-3) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available under law as well as to approach this Court.
